On Friday, the Aggie Theatre will not only be a place for live music, but art and fashion, too, as the venue hosts "B.A.M. - A Night of Beauty, Art and Music."

This fundraising event will benefit The Fort Collins Museum of Contemporary Art and bring attention to fashion, art and music, said artist Brandon Bullard.

"It's such a crazy, fun time," Bullard said. "We will have live music, painting, live sculpture, runway fashion shows... So anyone interested in any of those things will have a great time."

Fort Collins may not be as cosmopolitan as bigger cities, but it has a vibrant art scene that is worthy of celebration, said Morgan Pfaelzer, FCMOCA associate director of marketing.

"It's such an important thing for the community," Pfaelzer said. "We want to attract a young, diverse group of people, which makes this a very bohemian time."
